#### **CONTENT**

There are currently five main content categories on Reverie Society. Depending on how things go, I've been considering adding one more: Creativity (or something along that line)

##### *Reading*

Discussions about books, lists, recommendations, etc.

##### *Writing*

Tips, sharing a personal experience, prompts, rants?

##### *Blogging*

Tips, tutorials, discussions, etc.

##### *Introversion*

Personal experiences, discussions and tips

##### *Reviews*

Mainly YA books, but also NA

## **THE POST**

- Minimum 300 words
- Good spelling and grammar are the best
- Offensive things are not allowed. Ever.
- Keep it professional. This doesn't equal *serious* or *unfun*. There is a way of maintaining your voice without compromising professionalism. I'm working on this myself so this is something we'll work on together!
- Swearing (never at real people though!) is ok. But don't go overboard.
- Emojis are ok, but again, don't overdo it.

## **HOW GUEST POSTING WORKS**

1. You've got an idea and you pitch it via the contact form at the blog.
2. You'll have two weeks to send the post, for publication on third week after receipt. If something happens, don't hesitate to let me know so we can work something else. Life happens!
3. Post must be sent in HTML format with any pictures used attached to the email. **Don't forget to indicate where in the post goes each image.** You can do so by using this as placeholder: ``
4. Email must include short author description, a photo and social links you want featured.
5. You don't need to provide a featured image.

## **BENEFITS**

- In terms of exposure, since the point is leveling up, the audience won't be of hundreds -I apologize for that. Still though, posts will be promoted through twitter.
- Promoting posts on instagram doesn't work as well, but shoutouts do (in moderation of course) So on post day, I'll mention post, and also your IG account if you've got one!

## **HOW CONTRIBUTING WORKS**

1. As a contributor, you can write and edit your posts directly on the blog. You'll have your own username, so there's no need to send any material.
2. According to schedule agreed on, you'll be expected to have finished the draft 3 days prior to scheduled publication.
3. Should something happen, we can work something out. The schedule is just a means to keep ourselves organized.

## **BENEFITS**

- Contributors actually get the role of contributors on the blog and get to write and edit their posts directly on the blog dashboard.
- As a result, contributors' name appear on the post as the author when it's published.
- Contributors and their blogs will be featured on a separate page
- They can choose a category or more to 'specialize on' and that will info will be displayed on the contributors page as well.
- Benefits of guest posters apply!

**Contributor openings will depend on number of people already set as contributors and how often they have chosen to help out.**
